Collaborative approach

- PA's worked with EEAC consultants and lead EM&V consultants to develop EM&V document
- Great deal of information to pull together in a short amount of time
- Not 100% consensus reached yet between PA's and EEAC consultants
 - Follow up work before Oct 29th filing
 - Work will continue after Oct 29th filing
 - Document includes caveats: studies could change, studies could be added, and PAs will continue to provide EM&V updates throughout 2011 and 2012

EM&V document includes:

- Update on current EM&V research
 - 39 studies ongoing
 - Included:
 - the type of study
 - a brief description of the study
 - estimated date of completion
- Examples:
 - From impact studies on gas large C&I custom & prescriptive, to residential and low income non energy benefits, to a multi-family potential study

EM&V document includes:

- Detailed future planned research
 - Another 36 studies
 - Some phase II from ongoing list
 - Included: same information
 - Type, description, completion date
 - Examples:
 - From market study for HTR lighting market, to an impact study of MassSAVE, to impact work for CHP and behavioral programs
- Research priorities for each area
 - Higher level strategic approaches
