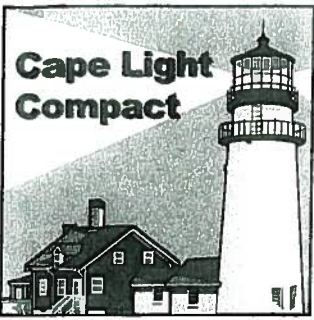
Over the 2013-2015 planning period, the Compact budgeted \$17,114 for Residential sponsorships and \$14,411 for C&I sponsorships
. To date the Compact has spent \$16,732 on the Residential sponsorships and \$17,636 on C&I sponsorships, as supported by the attached invoices.

The Compact values NEEP, CEE, TopTen, New Buildings Institute, Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce and other energy efficiency partners whose work supports both local and statewide programs and provides immeasurable assistance in energy efficiency education for consumers.
