Dear Commissioner Mahony:

On behalf of Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company d/b/a Unitil (“FGE” or the “Company”), please find enclosed a revised version of the Exhibit FGE-4 previously filed on November 21, 2023. Exhibit FGE-4 provides the narrative for the Company’s proposed Mid-Term Modifications (“MTM”) for its Residential New Buildings Program and its Residential Existing Buildings Program. Specifically, the revision included in this filing clarifies that the Company seeks an additional funding amount of \$200,000 for Residential New Buildings Program, representing a 47 percent increase, and additional funding amount of \$1,700,000 for the Residential Existing Buildings program, representing a 24 percent increase. There are no substantive changes to the Company’s proposed MTM from those initially filed.

Consistent with the Guidelines, and D.P.U. 22-94, the Company is filing this revised initial filing with the Department and the Energy Efficiency Advisory Council (“EEAC”) contemporaneously.
