Dear Commissioner Mahony:

Consistent with Section 3.8.2(c) of the Energy Efficiency Guidelines (“Guidelines”) and the order issued by the Department of Public Utilities (the “Department”) in D.P.U. 21-125, NSTAR Gas Company d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource” or the “Company”) hereby submits Exhibit NSTAR Gas-4, the narrative for its five proposed Residential and Commercial and Industrial (“C&I”) Mid-Term Modifications (“MTMs”). Through this filing, NSTAR Gas requests approval for the following for the 2022-2024 term:


- increase spending by \$1,134,000 for its Residential New Buildings Program resulting in the authority to spend up to \$6,959,000, representing a 19 percent increase of the budget previously approved in D.P.U. 21-125;
- increase spending by \$24,351,000 for its Residential Existing Buildings Program resulting in the authority to spend up to \$132,961,000 representing a 22 percent increase of the budget previously approved in D.P.U. 21-125;
- increase spending by \$1,177,000 for its Residential Hard-To-Measure Program resulting in the authority to spend up to \$7,562,000, representing a 18 percent increase of the budget previously approved in D.P.U. 21-125;
- increase spending by \$4,702,000 for its C&I New Buildings Program resulting the authority to spend up to \$9,142,000, representing a 106 percent increase of the budget previously approved in D.P.U. 21-125; and

- decrease spending by \$13,223,000 for its C&I Sector resulting in the authority to decrease spending to \$54,872,000, representing a 19 percent decrease of the budget previously approved in D.P.U. 21-125.

Consistent with the Guidelines, and D.P.U. 22-94, the Company is filing this initial filing with the Department and the Energy Efficiency Advisory Council (“EEAC”) contemporaneously.
