On July 17, 2023, and consistent with Section 3.8.2(c) of the Energy Efficiency Guidelines (“Guidelines”) and the order issued by the Department of Public Utilities (the “Department”) in D.P.U. 21-122, Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company d/b/a Unitil (“FG&E” or the “Company”) submitted for the Department’s consideration four proposed Residential, Commercial and Industrial (“C&I”), and Income Eligible Mid-Term Modifications (“MTMs”). The Department docketed this petition as D.P.U. 23-70.

Following the initial filing of these MTMs, the Company identified an error in the data tables that accompanied the petition as Exhibit FGE-2, in which there was an inadvertent formula error resulting in a misrepresentation of the lifetime MMBtu savings for the Income Eligible Sector and for the Income Eligible Existing Buildings Program. While this error is non-material to the Company’s request in this docket, for the sake of completeness and accuracy, the Company is providing, in Excel and .pdf format Exhibit FGE-2 (REVISED) with highlighted cells showing where the change was made.
