- ▶ **Executive Committee Councilor terms are for 2 years**
 - Excluding DOER and AGO
- ▶ **Three seats are opening up for nominations:**
 1. Councilor representing the **environmental community**
 2. Councilor representing the **residential including the low-income sector**
 3. Councilor representing the **commercial and industrial sector**

NOMINATION PROCESS

- ▶ **Councilors interested in nominating someone for one of the three open seats are asked to email ma-eeac@mass.gov by 5pm on Monday, November 30th**
 - Note: Councilors can nominate themselves
- ▶ **DOER will coordinate with those nominated to get a written statement from each candidate by December 11th**
 - Statements will be posted with the December EEAC materials
- ▶ **Candidates will be asked to read their statement during the December EEAC meeting**
- ▶ **EEAC will vote via roll call**
- ▶ **The candidates who receive the most votes will fill the Executive Committee seats**
