### NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL EXTRA-ORDINARY MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL IN FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2015

**MEETING DATES:** February 17, March 9, 2015.

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council ("Council") established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces the creation of additional extra-ordinary meetings of the Council. We anticipate the addition of another extra-ordinary session on or about March 3 but have yet to identify an available location. We shall publish such information as soon as we have reserved a location.

As earlier published, the Council chose to conduct these special meetings in a workshop format to educate its members in a more focused and concentrated manner concerning critical priorities and opportunities potentially available in each of the three customer sectors in the delivery of energy efficiency programs: (1) Residential, (2) Low-Income and (3) Commercial & Industrial. Each of these meetings is intended to inform the members of the Council in their determination of priorities and identification of opportunities in energy efficiency as they begin to consider the formulation of the Third Statewide Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans for the Years 2016 through 2018.

Both the rescheduled meeting and the two additional meetings will be held in Boston/Westborough. On **February 17, 2015 from 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm** at *100 Cambridge Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Rooms C & D, Boston, Massachusetts 02114*, there will be a meeting that will focus on priorities and opportunities in the **Commercial & Industrial Sector**, which had been previously cancelled by the recent snow storm. There will be an additional meeting addressing matters affecting the **Residential Sector** on **March 9, 2015 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** at *One South Station, Fifth Floor, Hearing Room A, of the Department of Public Utilities, Boston, Massachusetts 02110*.
