

Every three years, the Massachusetts' investor-owned utilities and qualified municipal aggregators (the "Program Administrators" or "PAs") develop a statewide investment plan, which includes savings and spending targets, implementation strategies, and descriptions of various initiatives. Pursuant to its statutory authority under G.L. c. 25, §22, the Energy Efficiency Advisory Council ("EEAC" or "Council") is responsible for reviewing and approving the plan and working with the PAs on implementation. Therefore, the EEAC is hosting a series of workshops during the process of generating its input into the 2022-2024 Three Year Statewide Energy Efficiency Investment Plan. This input will consist of program design and investment priorities which the members of the EEAC set forth for the PAs to incorporate into the Plan.

On March 12, 2020, Governor Baker issued an Order, temporarily allowing public bodies to conduct public meetings by phone and webinar, during the pendency of the State of Emergency related to COVID-19.
