NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED EXTRA-ORDINARY MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL IN FEBRUARY 2015

MEETING DATES: February 6, February 9, 2015.

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council ("Council") established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces the creation of several extra-ordinary meetings of the Council. As a result of the blizzard earlier this week that prompted the cancellation of two of these previously scheduled meetings, the Council announces the new dates and locations for these two meetings.

As earlier published, the Council chose to conduct these special meetings in a workshop format to educate its members in a more focused and concentrated manner concerning critical priorities and opportunities potentially available in each of the three customer sectors in the delivery of energy efficiency programs: (1) Residential, (2) Low-Income and (3) Commercial & Industrial. Each of these meetings is intended to inform the members of the Council in their determination of priorities and identification of opportunities in energy efficiency as they begin to consider the formulation of the Third Statewide Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans for the Years 2016 through 2018.

Each of these rescheduled meetings will be held in Boston. On **February 6, 2015 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** at *100 Cambridge Street, 2nd Floor Conference Room A, Boston, Massachusetts 02114*, there will be a meeting that will focus on priorities and opportunities in the **Commercial & Industrial Sector**. On **February 9 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** at *100 Cambridge Street, 2nd Floor Conference Rooms C + D, Boston, Massachusetts 02114*, the Council has scheduled a meeting which will address priorities and opportunities in the **Residential Sector**.
