Hi Ian and Maggie-

Nice job on the EEAC resolution. Thanks for the opportunity to comment.

My primary comment is one that I have made a few times before: the resolution will be more effective if we prioritize the comments. The resolution includes a very long list of recommendations -- more than the PAs can reasonably be expected to address. Moreover, even if there were time to address all of the comments, they do not deserve equal time; some comments are much more important than others.

While we may not want to delete any of the recommendations, would it be possible for the Council to identify its top 5? Here is my top 5:

Peak demand -- an offering in every territory (Cross-cutting b.i)
C&I reporting -- break outs for CHP and upstream (C&I C.a. and b)
LED streetlights (C&I I.a., b., and c)
Whole house program -- extensive review of customer experience (residential B.b)
MF retrofit -- single point of contact (Residential D.a)
