Allow me to suggest that the DOER 2022-2024 Three-Year Plan is hopelessly inadequate and needs to be sent back to the drawing board.

The plan is cautious business as usual. It needs to be bold. On its own showing, the plan is inadequate to the task of having the building sector meet the statutory carbon emissions goals of "An Act creating a next-generation roadmap for Massachusetts climate policy." The plan needs to be redrawn to create a program which will cause the building sector to meet the roadmap goals.

Moreover, MassSave is no longer part of the climate change solution. With its subsidization of conversions to natural gas, MassSave has become part of the problem. The money being spent on conversion to natural gas needs to be spent on conversion to heat pumps.
